The 16-unit, 12-story building at 8955 Collins Avenue is being developed by Sapir Corp. and designed by Citterio with Kobi Karp. It's expected to be delivered this summer, according to a release. De la Torre previously led sales at The Four Seasons Hotel and Residences at the Surf Club. Units at Arte by Antonio Citterio start at \$10.2 million and go up to \$40 million.

Compass Florida brought on the Simmonds Team from Keller Williams. The group, led by Amy and John Simmonds, includes nine agents and staff. They focus on North Palm Beach, including Jupiter, Abacoa, Jupiter Beach, Jupiter Farms, Juno Beach, Palm Beach Gardens and Tequesta.
